We proudly provide daily care for adults between the ages of 18 and up who have been affected by cognitive and/or physical disabilities. In addition, we offer support and resources for those caregivers in need of assistance.

Divine Destiny Adult Care, Inc. began as a result of a caregiver who had very little support, resources, or advocacy in how to best care for her father and her son. Respite care was limited due to financial hardships and work obligations. It became evident, that the need for this type of service within Johnston County was long overdue and non-existent.

These services are provided in a home-like environment by committed, nurturing and professionally trained staff. Our day program allows our participants to receive the daily care they need, so that their caregivers can receive a well-deserved break or have the option to return to work. The second is to provide support, resources and advocacy for those caregivers who are in dire need of daily assistance and support group meetings.
